



Eastern European GI-N2K Workshop

connected to the National GIS Conference,
26 May, 2016, Debrecen (Hungary)

The Eastern European GI-N2K Workshop is open for all and free of charge. A technical session will be organized on 26th May from 2pm till 4pm. After this hands-on session, the VirLaBoK (Virtual Laboratory for the Book of Knowledge) system will be demonstrated at the Conference exhibition area (Main Hall). A poster session invites contributions on strategies, tools and contents for the design of a 'modern' GI curricula.

The **technical session** will introduce the GI-N2K project results from various perspectives, including its content base, didactical aspects, technology-supported design strategies and real-world use cases.

The demonstrations at the **exhibition** will cover all components of the new VirLaBoK:

- The data repository including the Book of Knowledge itself (the knowledge areas, units and topics based on ontologies), metadata and already defined courses, job profiles, etc.
- The dynamic platform to define and update knowledge areas, units and topics including a wiki that allows discussion between GIS&T experts and users of the BoK.
- A series of tools to use the VirLaBoK repository to define courses, learning paths and job profiles.

During the workshop, the use of VirLaBoK can be tested through examples and case studies. Participants from academia and industry are invited to try their own cases in education or job profiling.
